



Announcement of The Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering  
Topic: Policy on travelling control and report for TGGGS students and exchange students at TGGGS  
for preventing spreading of COVID-19 disease

According to the severe epidemic of coronavirus (Coronavirus Diseases 2019, COVID-19), the Sirindhorn International Thai-German Graduate School of Engineering (TGGGS) asks for collaboration from all TGGGS students and exchange students at TGGGS to postpone or cancel travelling trips to abroad, especially to the listed high-risk countries, from now on until the epidemic situation has been relieved.

The students, who have returned from abroad or have interacted with any COVID-19 infected patient or high-risk person from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2020 onwards, are demanded by the university regulations to inform the TGGGS academic affairs about the travelling history without delay. The students, who avoid reporting the travelling history, can be prosecuted by the university regulations as well as the Thai laws. For the exchange students, the misconduct against this announcement will be also reported to the origin universities.

Referring to the government regulations enacted since 1 February 2020, COVID-19 is classified as a dangerous contagious disease. Concealing the necessary information about the risks of spreading the COVID-19 disease can be prosecuted with a maximum fine of 20,000 THB.

This announcement is enacted from 13 March 2020 onwards.
